And though many possess capable intellect and present intriguing ideas, few works are compelling enough to stand apart from the pack. An ambitious text addressing the sorts of broad themes and questions that send parents and pastors running for cover, Andrew's treatment is a masterpiece of simplicity that belies the depth of the concepts within. With clarity and vigor, Andrew describes “universal learning” and provides tools for readers to begin to understand and practice this essential act.

Of course, mention of extra dimensions, universal energy, and spiritual beings sets off the “New Age” alarm. The charming thing about Andrew is that he accepts this moniker and even self-labels his work as being such. He unabashedly presents his views, views which are, though radical, well-thought and meticulously argued.

Your-Never Ending Life: Book 1 of the Universal Learning Series is a must-read for anyone interested in understanding the purpose of life—which makes this extraordinary work a must-read for everyone, regardless of age, nationality, or faith. If there were more Sandy Andrew's in the world, humanity would be much improved. Too bad this author is such a stunning original.
